Host an Event

Businesses, governments, academic institutions, arts and music organizations, and nonprofits are encouraged to participate in InnovATL by hosting an event.

InnovATL events are promoted through the official website and community partner platforms. Expect to see multiple, overlapping activations each day surrounded by anchor events.

Examples of events:

- Conferences including Venture Atlanta & A3C
- Showcases demo days, award ceremonies
- Informational events panels, workshops, tours, summits, etc.
- Networking events parties, dinners, happy hours, etc.
- Public and private events are both welcome
- Free and fee-based events are both welcome



Best Practices for Event Hosts

As we champion collective efforts across the Atlanta metro area, we want to be intentional about leveraging our unique communities, while *fostering a welcoming and respectful experience*.

- Event hosts are encouraged to think about bold ways to identify the missing threads to stitch together a space that invites *everyone* into the room.
- Event hosts <u>are responsible</u> for finding a venue and organizing their own events. *All events must take place within the Atlanta Metro Region or online.*
- Event hosts <u>are responsible</u> for managing the registration, costs, and attendance for their events.
- Event hosts should consider accessibility, transit, and parking.



Best Practices for Event Hosts

- Event hosts will promote their own event, including linking to event details on the InnovATL website (to be launched May 8).
- When choosing a date, consider the suggested themes and audiences listed on the Event Guidelines page. Also consider other events already planned for that same date/time. Check for conflicts on the <u>Startup Atlanta Events Calendar</u>.
- It is okay to have overlapping events, especially if you are attracting a different audience. We cannot guarantee attendance at any events.


